



Driver's Education

Basic information: Students must be at least 14 years, 6 months old to take a Driver Education class. Students are required to complete 30 hours in the driver education classroom and 6 hours behind the wheel instruction. Driver education classes held here at EWA are scheduled for the first week of Fall Break and the first week of Spring Break. Behind the wheel driving is conducted after school. Students are driven by age, oldest called first, after completing the classroom phase of driver education.

Students are also required by the NCDMV and dropout prevention services to pass at least 3 of 4 classes at East Wake Academy High School to obtain or maintain a learner's permit or a driver license. Driver eligibility certificates are validated by EWA's Admissions Coordinator.

*Call the High School Office 919-404-0444 to set up an appointment to acquire a Driver Eligibility Certificate.

Class Registration: The cost to take Drivers Education is \$65. Registration forms will be available in EWA's high school office a month before the scheduled class. Return the completed form to the high school office and payment must be made online. A schedule of classes offered on EWA's campus will be added soon, School's Event Calendar .

Behind the Wheel Training: Students are driven by age, oldest called first, after completing the classroom phase of driver education. Each is responsible for creating his/her own driving schedule, so please work with them when called for BTW instruction. If you are driving during the summer or break, you may be called by another Jordan Driving School personnel.
