



Driver's Education Course

Driver's Education Course will be offered on East Wake Academy campus in the high school's Eagle Hall. This class will be taught by a representative of Jordan Driving School and will be held during the first week of Fall track out and first week of Spring track out: from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm daily for five (5) days. The State of NC requires that a student attend **ALL** of the classes. Any absences must be cleared with Ms. Linda St. Clair (Email: stclair56@hotmail.com) prior to the beginning of the class.

The following are the requirements of the students enrolled in this course:

- *Obtain a registration form from EWA's high school office.
- *Complete the form and return it to the high school office.
- *You will be emailed about two weeks prior to class; the email will instruct you to pay the registration fee online only, as well as an explanation of the class itinerary and expectations.
- * Students need to bring a copy of their birth certificate, passport or state ID on the first day of class.
- *The State requires all 30 hours of class. Please do not accept a seat in a class you cannot complete.

Uniforms are not required for this class however; students are to dress appropriately (Wake County dress code does apply). Students will have thirty (30) minutes for lunch and should bring a bag lunch. Vending machines may not be available.

Your student will be scheduled to drive following completion of the class. (Six (6) hours of "behind the wheel training" is required). The driving class will be held the week following but not every student will have the opportunity to drive during this time. Arrangements will be made with an instructor for a driving class once school is back in session.

***Eligible 8th graders interested in Drivers Education class during summer:** This summer Jordan Driving School will offer Drivers Education classes throughout the area. (EWA will not offer the classes during summer but we will offer classes at EWA this Fall as well as Spring school year.) The summer locations are listed on the back of the form. (Go to Jordan Driving school's website (www.jordandriving.com) to verify the class is not full). Once you fill out the form either fax to Jordan Driving school (fax # **919-662-2628**) or turn in your form to your first choice. Jordan Driving school suggests that you submit your form by April 24th to participate in priority registration. If you have further questions call **919-772-4877** or contact the lead Driver's Education teacher for the location you are considering. **Eligible - Student has to be (14 years and 6 months old) at the time of class.**
